



The Post Office - your local cash point - at the Parish Hall, Mondays 1.15pm to 4.15pm, Wednesdays 9.15am to 12.15pm & Fridays 9.15am to 12.15pm. Their system is now connected via a land line ensuring a reliable service. It has the same services as a regular Post Office including parcels, banking and cash withdrawal from most banks, Car Tax and Birthday Gift Cards with a value of your choice usable at most stores. Currency available to order (order Friday/Monday collect on Wednesday; order Wednesday collect Friday)
