COMMUNITY NEWS.

Following the opening up of the hospitality and tourism sector two weeks ago, levels of infection and new cases in the South West have continued to remain among the lowest in the country – and South West leaders paid tribute to the businesses which have opened up for playing their part in keeping the area COVID-safe.

We are now entering the crucial time at the start of the summer tourism peak. As more residents take a break with their families, and as further lockdown restrictions are lifted, the onus is on each and every one of us to do our part in helping prevent the spread of the virus, which remains a serious threat to public health.

So, the message in the South West is clear – whether you are visiting, living here or a resident about to go on holiday – stick with us and keep following the guidance to keep everyone safe.

That means continuing to observe social distancing, getting tested if you have symptoms, self-isolating when required to, washing hands regularly, wearing a face covering, and making use of hand sanitiser where it's available.

West Down Parish Hall - The Government permitted community halls to open from July 4th subject to strict regulations designed to make the halls a safe place to meet. Those regulations have now been implemented and the hall is ready for use. However, 2 meter spacing still applies and discs have been stuck to the floor to indicate the spacing. This means that the maximum number of people in the main hall is restricted to 20. There are paper towels in the toilets and hand sanitisers are available. There is a special cleaning program to ensure everything that is touched is cleaned. There is an updated risk assessment and supplementary hiring conditions. At the moment singing and exercise are not permitted but this will probably change soon. Contact our booking clerk, Keith Oades as usual when you wish to book the Hall.

The Crown Inn – is open from Tuesday to Saturday 5pm-10pm Serving food until 9pm and on Sunday 12pm–2pm. Take away available. Booking is essential and all Covid-19 restrictions apply.

West Down Village Green Field - NEWS FLASH! most residents know that the Community Field Trustees where able to keep this facility open during the COVID lockdown, but had to close the Play area, during this time we have been able to refurbish the play area (many thanks to Tony Verney for all of his hard work) I am pleased to confirm that it is now open to all.

Please will all users do so in line with Government Covid guidelines. Community Field Chair.

Mondays 1.15pm - 4.15pm, Wednesdays 9.15am - 12.15pm & Fridays 9.15am - 12.15pm.
