**St Calixtus Church – Important Notice re Remembrance Services Sunday 8th November 2020** This year, because of Covid 19 restrictions, we are unable to observe Remembrance Sunday in the usual way. Instead, we will be holding a short act of remembrance at the war memorial in the churchyard. This will start at 10.45am and a 2-minute silence will be observed at 11.00am.
