Minutes of Management Committee Meeting held on Wednesday 12th March 2025 7.00pm at the Parish Hall

- 2. Minutes of Committee Management Meeting held 12th February 2025 were approved.

3. Treasurer's report:

David Ayre emailed a copy of the balance sheet to all committee members as at 11th March 2025.

<u>Income</u>: £763.09 (Bookings £409, Good Energy £148.55, ND Lottery £21.50, Pearce - final payment of party damage £125, Table Tennis Table donation £20, Old Parish Hall Chairs donation £25, bank interest £14.04).

Expenditure: £719.43 (Cleaning £360, Window Cleaning £20, British Gas 281.06, EDF Energy £58.37).

- Latest electricity bill is significantly down recently installed solar storage battery paying dividends.
- Accounts awaiting signing off were still at the accountants.

6. Booking Clerk Report (inc. attracting new hall users)

School has cleared their outstanding balance of £120.

Bookings slightly down but shows signs of picking up.

We need a 'stand in' booking clerk for when Keith Oades goes to Australia in April.

7. Cleaning

Sue Squire had complained to David Maidment that there was a horrible smell coming from the dishwasher at a recent event. This was due to the dishwasher not being emptied correctly and the water going stagnant. Keith Oades is now running an empty 'cleaning' wash once a month.

8. Hall Developments and Car Park

 Community Space/Storage extension project – awaiting final plan/building schedule from Lewis (architect) that can be used for obtaining builder quotes. Builders still to be nominated and funding opportunities to be sought (approach funding sources that helped build the new toilet facilities). - Surge Protection James Electrical to install surge protection devices in March.
- <u>Solar battery</u> now fully installed and working: from recent electricity bills we seem to be benefitting from reduced costs. Terry King will be meeting with Andy Hill (Bespoke Electrical) on 18th March at 10am. Require guarantee and working instructions. A phone app is available for monitoring solar panel battery management David Ayre has volunteered the use of his smartphone.
- Table tennis table £20 donation received and the table has been removed from the Hall.

9. Fund Raising

- John Stainer has received a quote from DCS to tarmac the gravelled car parking area. Costs quoted ranged from £25,511 to £32,989. Quote passed on to WDPC who will pass it on the Devon District Council for section 106 consideration.
- Hall entrance pillar lights Keith and Ian have installed repaired/improved solar pillar lights and they appear to be working effectively. No further action required.

 years, we still managed to raise a total of £868.18 (£73.22 down on last year). This was an
